Executive Summary

The Jenks Wastewater Treatment Facility is fully in compliance with discharge criteria established by the Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality.

December was the ninth month of year three for the U.S. Water Utility Group at the Jenks Public Works Authority Wastewater Treatment Plant. We currently have four full-time employees, after one employee left as of December 5th. A new employee has been hired with a scheduled starting date of January 12th. U.S. Water completed 216 work orders over the course of the month. Quarterly biomonitoring was conducted in the first week of December, all results passed federal standards.

The following plant maintenance were completed during the month of December:

The sludge box was down for several weeks for major maintenance. Plant staff cleared the drains, removed a large amount of rust, painted the inside panels, pressure washed screens and steel grating and installed several additional drains as well as two cleanouts. Structural repairs to the center filtration system were conducted with new bracing welded in.

The polymer mixing system was found to have a faulty flow sensor and pressure transducer. Bypassing these control parameters resulted in more efficient use of polymer and dilution water.

Plant staff installed new doors and increased the size of the polymer room in order to keep polymer totes inside of the climate-controlled room.

The UPS and backup batteries were replaced in the control panel for the west headworks bar screen; these items failed in November and were determined to be under warrantee.

The following lift station maintenance was completed during the month of December:

Commerce Park, Forrest Hills, Country Meadows, B Street and Dutchers Crossing lift stations were de-ragged.

New level indicator floats were installed at Brookwood lift station.

Vacuum pumps were repaired at Village on Main and Country Meadows lift stations.

Yorktown 4 lift station had the battery replaced on the Mission Control alarm system.

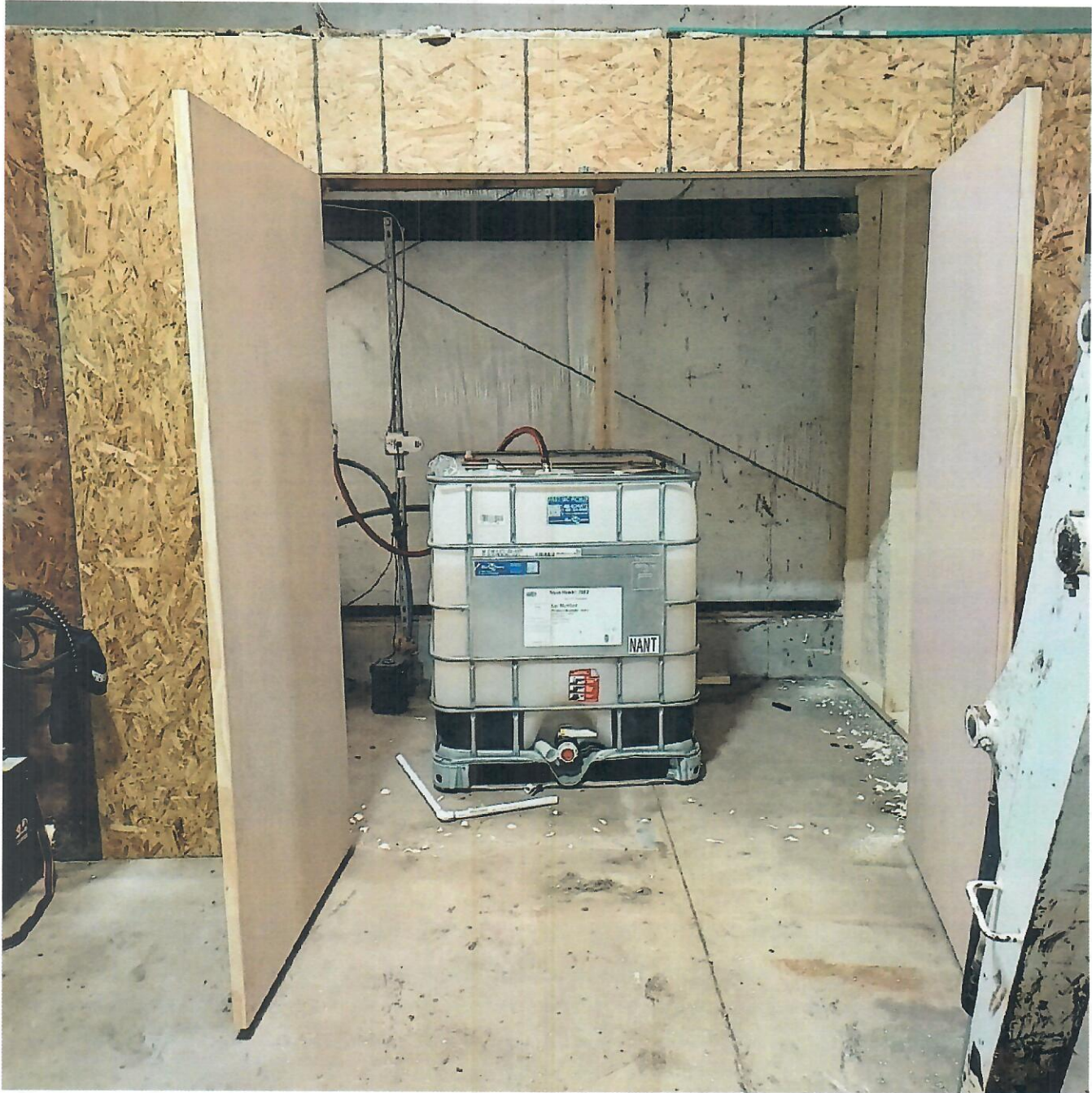

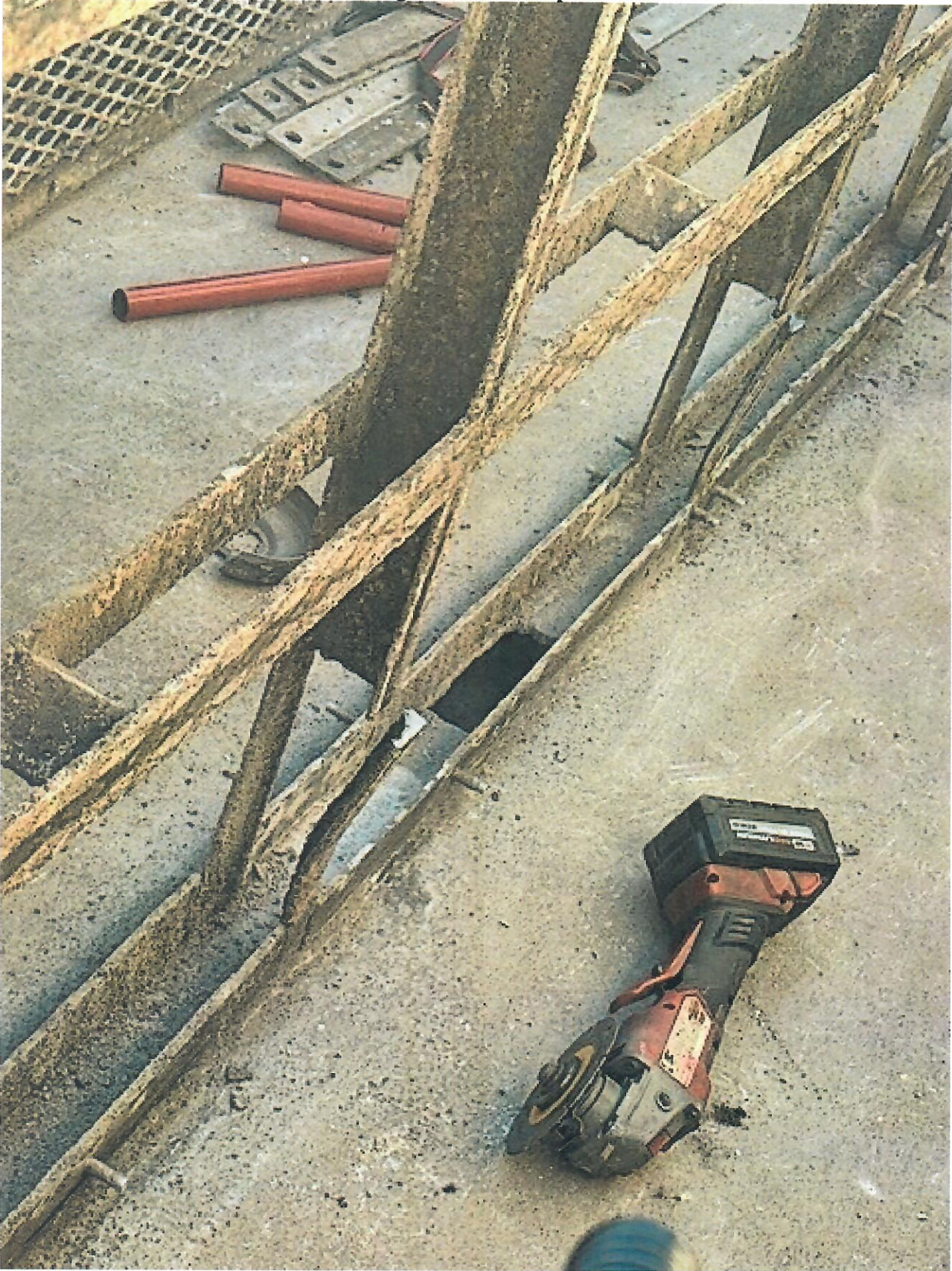

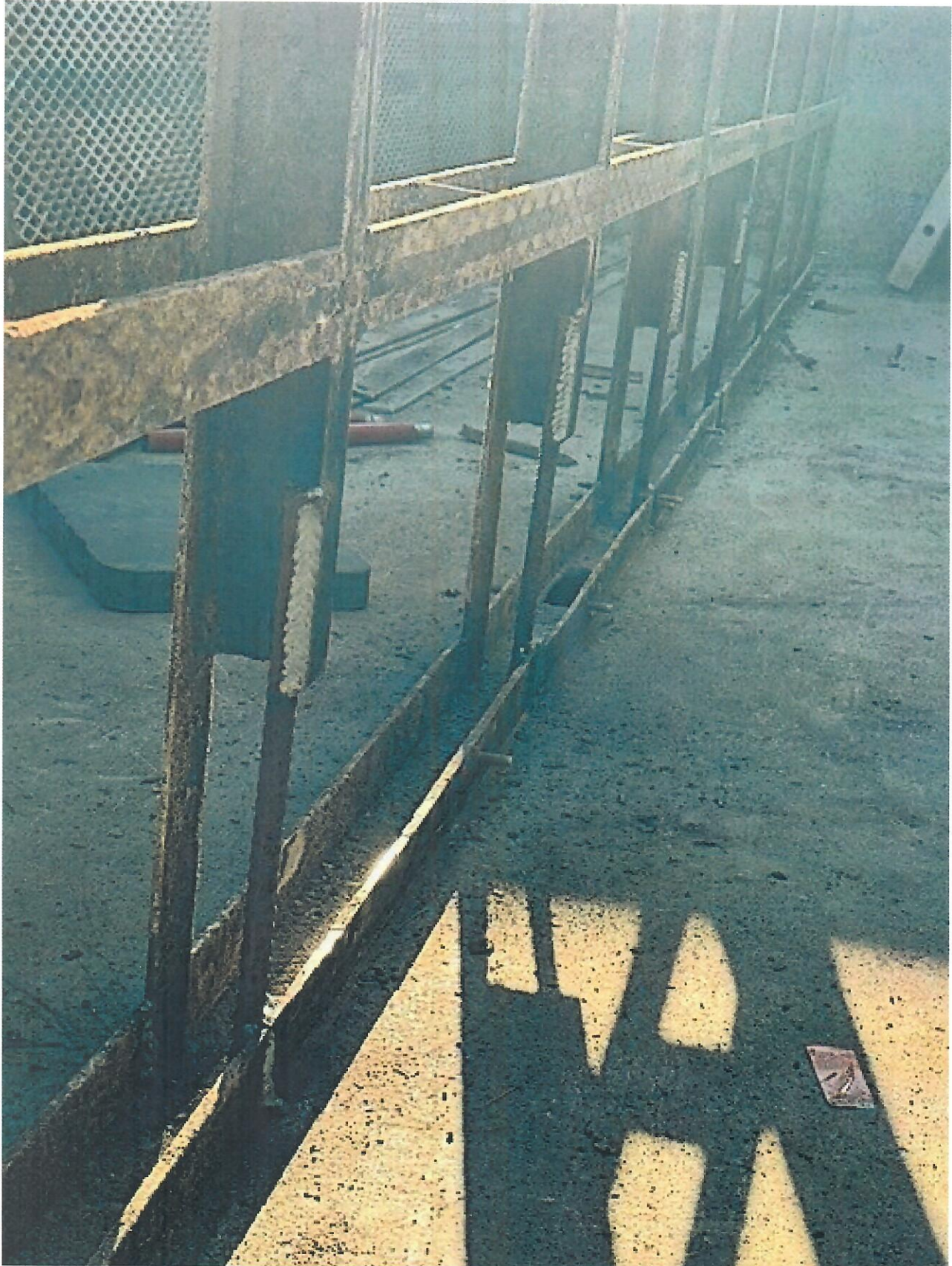
Sludge Box After Repairs

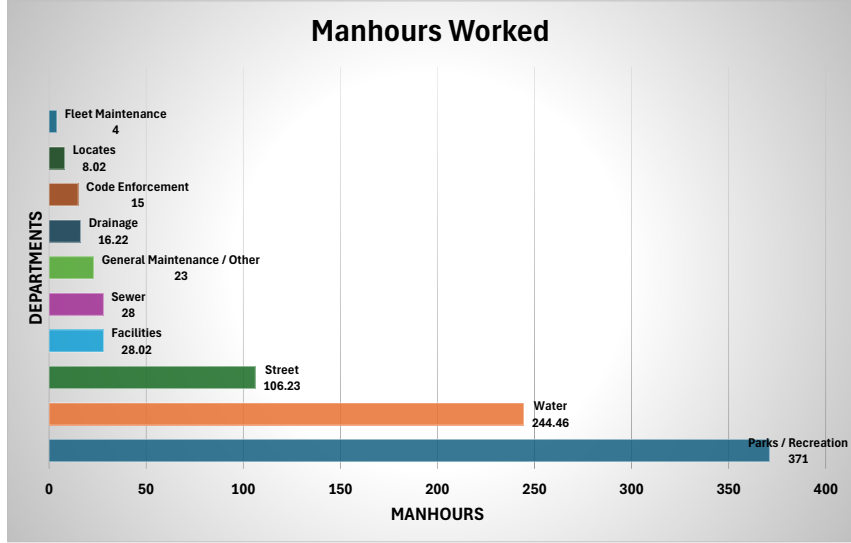

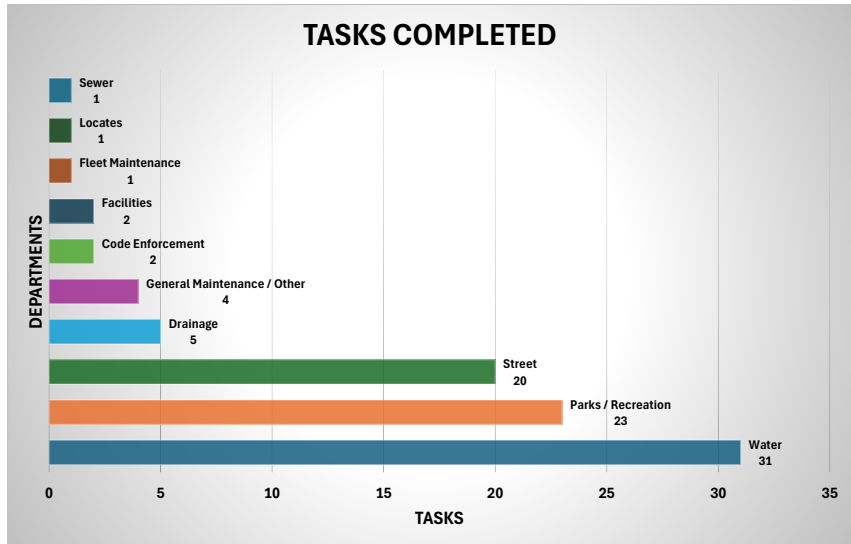

Engineering Projects – Major Highlights

January 15, 2026

STREET IMPROVEMENTS PROJECTS

Elm Street (111th Street to 131st Street):

- Contractor is continuing to install the stormwater collection system moving south from 115th St along the west side of Elm St.
- Contractor is installing road subgrade and fill dirt behind the future curbline along the westside of Elm St. between W. 115th St. and W. 120th St.

Elwood Avenue (111th Street to Main Street) Project:

- An updated agreement between the City and ONG for the utility relocation required for this project was fully executed on December 30, 2025

106th Street Extension (Elm Street to Lewis Avenue) Design:

- Consultant has submitted preliminary plan for City staff's review.

PARK/TRAIL/SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS

121st Street Trail (Elm to Elwood):

- Encroachments in the project area have been resolved.

RAISE Grant Trail:

- Consultant is correcting the easement documents to account for the right-of-way dedication and easements provided in the plat with the new apartment complex north of E. "K" Pl.
- Consultant has provided PS&E plans for Segment A for City staff to review.

N. 5th St. Sidewalk Extension:

- City staff, ODOT, and the selected Consultant held a meeting to clarify the scope of work for the project.

Parkwest Trail Extension:

- City staff, ODOT, and the selected Consultant are scheduled to hold a meeting on January 16, 2026 to clarify the scope of work for the project.

WATERLINE CAPITAL PROJECTS

121st ST. Waterline Extension:

- Consultant has submitted the permit to ODOT for review and is currently waiting for a response from ODOT.

Water System Master Plan and Model:

- City staff selected engineering firms by an RFQ process to provide RFPs to create a water system master plan and model the water system.
- Over the upcoming weeks City staff will review the RFPs and hold interviews with the firms to select a consultant for this project.

CITY FACILITY PROJECTS

Fire Station #1

- Contractor is continuing to complete the punchlist.
- It is expected the Fire Department will begin operating out of the new station on January 26, 2026.
- The intersection of "B" and Elm has been restriped to accommodate the needs for the Fire Department.

COMMERCIAL PROJECTS

Riverfront South Centre Apartments (STUCO) ("K" Pl. & 5th St.):

- Contractor is installing the sanitary sewer line connect to the lift station wet well and will begin installing the force main from the lift stations starting the week of January 19, 2026.
- Contractor is continuing to install the stormwater infrastructure.

Eighteen Acre Ranch (116th St. & Elwood):

- Punchlist as been completed. Contractor is preparing the maintenance bond required for infrastructure acceptance.

Burn Boot Camp ("B" St. & Riverfront Ter.):

- Contractor is working to complete the parking lot pavement.

Motorsports Collective(Franklin St. & Adams St.):

- Contractor is constructing the storage buildings/garages.

BridgePoint (131st & Harvard):

- Contractor has provided passing Bac-T tests for the waterline and are working to install future water service lines and fire lines.

Bridging Hunger (East of Gateway Mortgage Group):

- Contractor has paved the parking lot and are submitting plans for review to adjust the southern entry.

S. James Ave. Extension:

- Developer's engineer has request a meeting with City staff to discuss the comments provided on the preliminary plans.

AAA Insurance ("A" St. & 5th St.):

STREET IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS

Elm Street (111th Street to 131st Street) Project: On October 15th Paragon Contractors, LLC was awarded the construction of Phase 1 (111th Street to 121st Street) and the 116th Street Trail. Standard Engineering + Testing Services was awarded a contract for Construction Management and Laboratory Services for Phase 1 (111th Street to 121st Street) and the 116th Street Trail Contractor is continuing to work on the pedestrian trail on the east side of Elm St. moving north from the 121st St. intersection. and Elm St. Contractor has completed the striping at the intersection of 121st St. and Elm St. allowing this intersection to be opened completely. Contractor is currently constructing the waterline relocation along the east side of Elm St. from 112th St. to 116th St. Contractor has created a “Shoo-Fly” at 116th St. to begin installing the steel casing across Elm St. for the CRWD#2 waterline relocation required for this project. Contractor is currently constructing the stormwater collection system along Elm St. north of 116th St. Contractor has completed the pressure test and Bac-T test for the CRWD#2 waterline and completed the tie-in for this line on December 10, 2025. Contractor is continuing to install the City waterline on the eastside of Elm St. between 112th St. and 116th St. Contractor has begun installation of the stormwater collection system on the westside of Elm St. north of 116th St.

Update:

Contractor is continuing to install the stormwater collection system moving south from 115th St along the west side of Elm St. Contractor is installing road subgrade and fill dirt behind the future curbline along the westside of Elm St. between W. 115th St. and W. 120th St.

Elwood Avenue (111th Street to Main Street) Project: All right-of-way has been acquired. Consultant provided final plans and all of the City’s comments have been addressed. City staff is working with ODOT to determine the funding available and with ONG for a utility relocation. Two Surface Transportation Block Grant (STBG) applications for federal funding to complete the utility relocation and construction were submitted to INCOG. INCOG has awarded FFY2026-2027 STBG funding for utility relocation in the total amount of \$2,100,000.00. The total federal funding of this awarded project is 80% of the total or \$1,680,000.00. City staff have contacted PSO/AEP to confirm their lines have been relocated and are not in conflict with the design of the project. ODOT is working to provide an updated agreement capturing all the awarded federal funding to date.

Update:

An updated agreement between the City and ONG for the utility relocation required for this project was fully executed on December 30, 2025.

106th Street Extension (Elm Street to Lewis Avenue) Design:

Consultant Progress: Plans/Specifications/Estimate (PS&E): West end PS&E development with the resolution of issues, interior drainage analysis for west end, annotating PS&E sheets for east end; Hydrology: finished preliminary hydraulics, waiting on existing hydraulic models to set profile for Polecat Creek, Future preparations will be put into the road design to allow for moving the lift station at a later date when required. Consultant is continuing to work on the design to update the street to a 3-lane street. The hydraulic contractor is continuing to work on their report to provide. The contractor is having to remodel the bridge over Polecat due to the first design not allowing enough water to pass without causing a rise in the floodplain. Consultant has completed approximately 75% of the justification letter and exhibits requested by the railroad for the at-grade railroad crossing required for this project. Consultant has been working on designing the stormwater collection system that will need to be installed at the intersection of 106th St. and Elm St. Consultant has submitted the justification letter and exhibits to city staff for review prior to submitting the documents to the railroad. Consultant is working to complete a preliminary set of plans for the new 3-lane design to be submitted to City staff for review by the end of the year.

Elwood Avenue (91st to 96th Street) Design: INCOG awarded \$625,000 (\$500,000 Federal, \$125,000 Local match) to this project for Right-of-Way acquisition. Right-of-way acquisition is on hold until an agreement with ODOT is in place for the right-of-way funding. Final plans have been accepted by staff. Staff is waiting on ODOT to provide the funding agreement for ROW acquisition. The local match was approved by City Council on October 15th, Right-of-Way acquisition is to proceed.

PARK/TRAIL/SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS

121st Street Trail (Elm to Elwood): Staff met with the consultant on November 9 and reviewed the conceptual layout and discussed how to address potential conflicts. City staff is working to address a couple of right-of-way encroachment issues. This project is scheduled to be let in October with ODOT. The project has been moved from letting in October to letting in September with ODOT. ODOT has moved the letting of this project back to October. ODOT has provided a Supplemental and Modification Agreement to allocate additional federal funding for this project, reducing the City's cost responsibility. This Supplemental and Modification Agreement is on the 9-2-2025 City Council agenda for approval. City staff has sent out letters to the properties encroaching into the right-of-way for 121st St. to inform the owners of the upcoming project and that they need to remove any of their property from the city right-of-way. ODOT opened bids on this project on October 9, 2025 and will be awarding the project in November or December. On November 3, 2025 ODOT awarded this project to Daris Contractors, LLC for \$838,180.00. A pre-construction meeting with City staff, ODOT, and Daris will take place in the upcoming months.

Update:

Encroachments in the project area have been resolved.

Aquarium Drive and Elm Street Trails: ODOT provided review comments on the preliminary plans. Staff is addressing ODOT's review comments. Staff will obtain a 408 Permit from the US Army Corps of Engineers for the trail connection between the Veterans Park Trail and the trail along 101st Street. In addition, Tulsa County is reviewing the plans for this trail connection. 60% plans have been submitted to ODOT for review. ODOT has returned comments on the 60% plans and City staff will work to address the comments and submit 90% plans to ODOT. City staff met on-site with the Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) to discuss the levee crossing and the necessary requirements associated with the crossing. City staff is working to update the plans and provide the USACE the necessary information for a 408 permit.

RAISE Grant Trail: This project was awarded by INCOG to design and construct two trail segments along the Arkansas River. Segment "A" begins approximately at 83rd St. and Elm St. extending south follow the toe of the levee to W. "K" Pl. before turning east and tying into the existing trail behind the Riverwalk development. Segment "B" begins at the end of the existing trail behind Waterfront Grill extending south along the top of the Arkansas River bank to the approximate location of the proposed Low Water Dam. The Consultant is scheduled to submit 90% plans by the end of September 2025 or early October 2025. Consultant is working to complete the right-of-way documents required for both segments of this project. Consultant is coordinating with ODOT to begin the NEPA evaluation for each segment. ODOT has stated this process will take approximately 9-10 months to complete. Consultant has provided the City with 90% plans for Segment A to review and the City is working with the Consultant to address a few items on Segment B before they submit 90% plans for the City to review. City staff have provided comments to the Consultant on the provided 90% plans for Segment A. The Consultant is working to address those comments and finalize the plans for Segment A. City staff are working with a contractor to begin right-of-way acquisition for Segment A of this project.

Update:

Consultant is correcting the easement documents to account for the right-of-way dedication and easements provided in the plat with the new apartment complex north of E. "K" Pl. Consultant has provided PS&E plans for Segment A for City staff to review.

Pedestrian Bridge Inspection: Consultant has provided a final inspection report which staff has accepted. Consultant has provided a draft presentation for City Council which staff is reviewing. Consultant gave a presentation at the City Council meeting on 08/05/2025 explaining their findings. This presentation was given prior to the agenda item regarding engineering contract to design the repairs to the pedestrian bridge.

During the INCOG FFY2026-2027 TAP funding period this project was awarded federal funding in the amount of \$40,000.00 for design and \$400,981.00 for construction. City staff and ODOT held interview with three (3) consultants to select a designer for this project on November 4, 2025. A consultant will be selected and an agreement completed in the next couple of months. After which this project's design will begin.

Update:

City staff, ODOT, and the selected Consultant held a meeting to clarify the scope of work for the project.

Parkwest Trail Extension: The project is to extend a trail for the dog park at Parkwest to Main St. and west to Elwood Ave. This extension will provide a connection between the three trail systems in Jenks W. 101st St. trail system, S. Elwood Ave trail system, and Leon "Red" Earp Nature Trail system. The trail will also provide safe pedestrian access to the Parkwest sports complex, Bark West dog park, and a local shopping center. Once a signed agreement with ODOT has been received, City Staff will begin the selection process and select a design consultant to complete the design of this project. City staff and ODOT held interview with three (3) consultants to select a designer for this project on November 4, 2025. A consultant will be selected and an agreement completed in the next couple of months. After which this project's design will begin.
