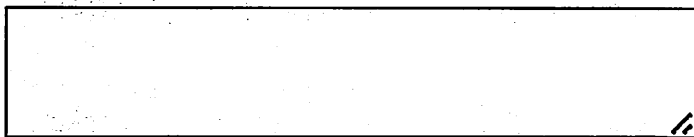

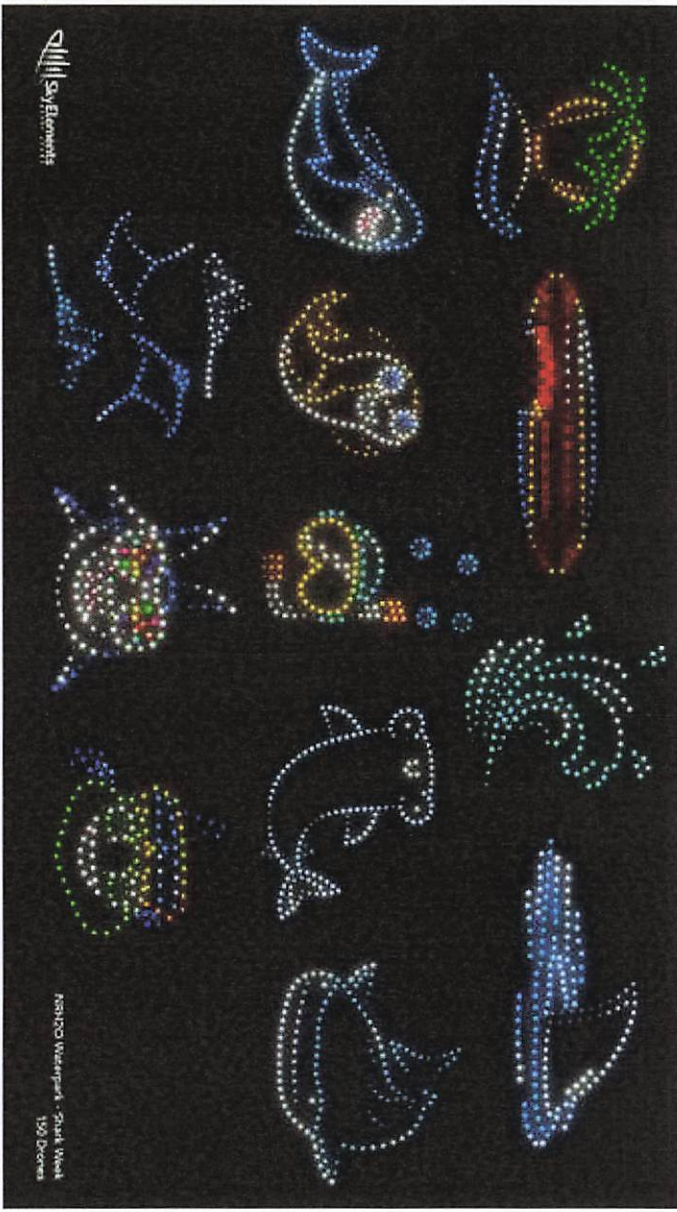

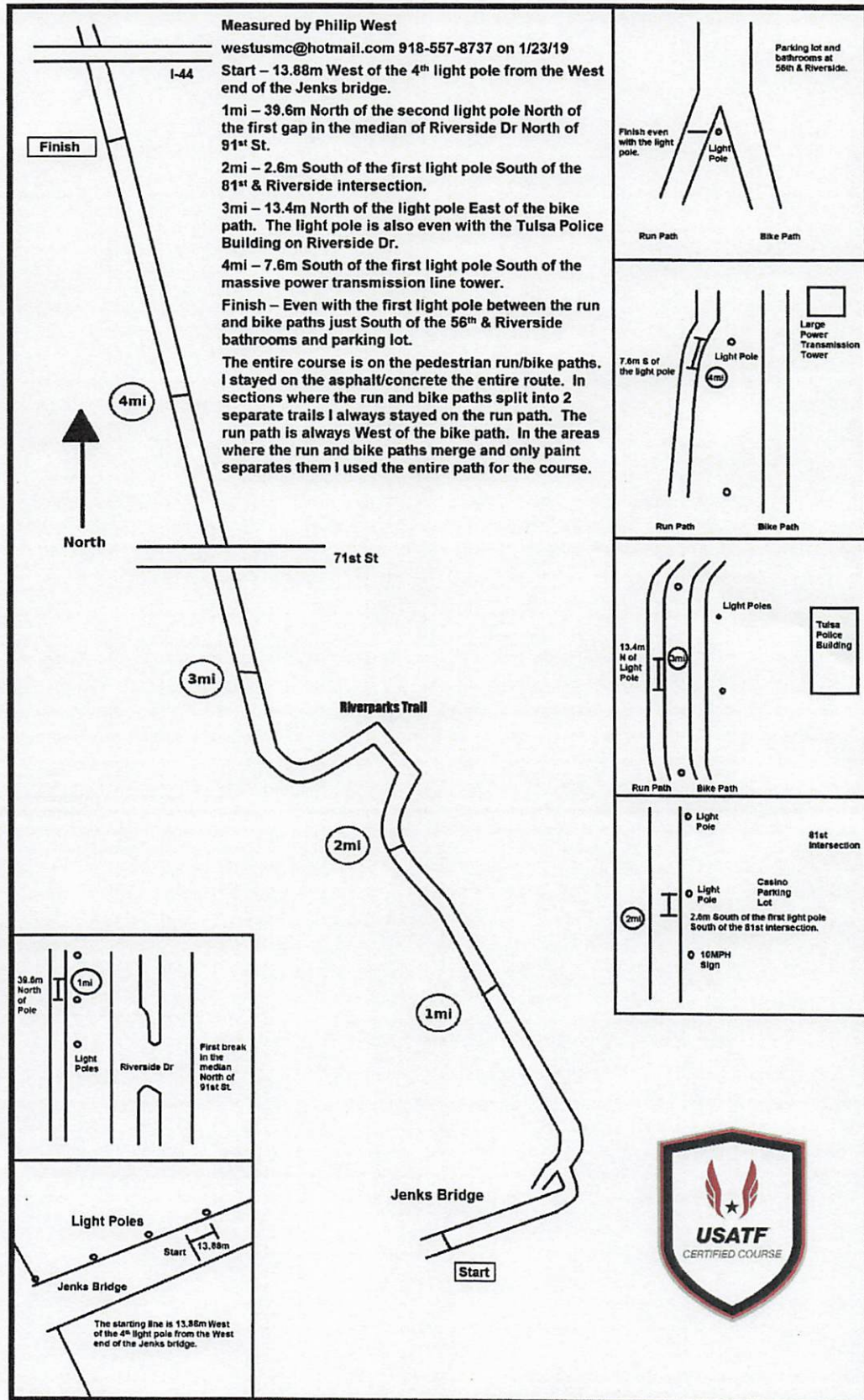

WHEREAS, pharmaceutical opioids have harmed the City of Jenks, Oklahoma and its citizens. This harm was created and exacerbated by the misconduct and illegal activities of pharmaceutical manufacturers, including by small generic opioid manufacturers.

WHEREAS, City of Jenks, Oklahoma, filed suit to address and seek recovery for the harms cause to it and its citizens.

WHEREAS, six opioid manufacturers and/or distributors, Associated Pharmacies, Inc., JM Smith Corporation, Louisiana Wholesale Drug Company, Morris and Dickson Co., North Carolina Mutual Wholesale Drug Company, Inc., and United Natural Foods, Inc. (collectively "Settling Remnant Defendants"), have agreed to settle the claims of certain subdivisions in the Remnant Defendants Settlement Agreement dated February 23, 2026.

THEREFORE, it was duly moved and seconded that the following resolution be adopted.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Jenks, Oklahoma hereby elects to, and approves, its participation in the Remnant Defendant Settlement Agreement, and authorizes its Mayor, City Manager, or other authorized designee, to execute the Remnant Defendants' Combined Subdivision Participation and Release Form contained in the Remnant Defendants' Settlement Agreement as Exhibit G, which participation and release form may be executed in the DocuSign platform.

THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City of Jenks, Oklahoma, further authorizes its Mayor, City Manager and legal counsel to take all actions

required by the Remnant Defendants Settlement Agreement to effectuate the Remnant Defendants Settlement Agreement for the benefit of City of Seminole, Oklahoma, including executing any documents required to finalize the participation of City of Seminole in the Remnant Defendants Settlement Agreement.

1. The Governmental Entity hereby elects to participate in the RDSA as a Participating Subdivision with each of the following six (6) Remnant Defendants that are parties to the RDSA: (1) Associated Pharmacies, Inc. (and American Associated Pharmacies), (2) J M Smith Corporation, (3) Morris and Dickson Co., L.L.C., (4) Louisiana Wholesale Drug Company, Inc., (5) North Carolina Mutual Wholesale Drug Company, Inc., and (6) United Natural Foods, Inc. (and SuperValu).
2. The Governmental Entity is aware of and has reviewed the RDSA, understands that all capitalized terms not defined in this Combined Participation Form have the meanings defined in the RDSA, and agrees that by executing this Combined Participation Form, the Governmental Entity elects to participate in the RDSA and become a Participating Subdivision as provided in the RDSAs.
3. The Governmental Entity shall promptly, and in any event no later than 14 days after the Reference Date and prior to the filing of the Consent Judgment, dismiss with prejudice any Released Claims that it has filed against any Released Entity in the RDSA. With respect to any Released Claims pending in *In Re National Prescription Opiate Litigation*, MDL No. 2804, the Governmental Entity authorizes the Plaintiffs’ Executive Committee to execute and file on behalf of the Governmental Entity a Stipulation of Dismissal with Prejudice for each of six (6) Remnant Defendants listed in Paragraph 1 above substantially in the form found at <https://nationalopioidsettlement.com/additional-settlements/>.
4. The Governmental Entity agrees to the terms of each of the RDSA pertaining to Participating Subdivisions as defined therein.

5. By agreeing to the terms of the RDSA settlements and becoming a Releasor, the Governmental Entity is entitled to the benefits provided therein, including, if applicable, monetary payments beginning after the Effective Date.
6. The Governmental Entity agrees to use any monies it receives through the RDSA solely for the purposes provided therein.
7. The Governmental Entity submits to the jurisdiction of the MDL Court and agrees to follow the process for resolving any disputes described in the RDSA.
8. The Governmental Entity has the right to enforce the RDSA as provided therein.
9. The Governmental Entity, as a Participating Subdivision, hereby becomes a Releasor for all purposes of the RDSA, including without limitation all provisions related to release of any claims, and along with all departments, agencies, divisions, boards, commissions, districts, instrumentalities of any kind and attorneys, and any person in his or her official capacity whether elected or appointed to serve any of the foregoing and any agency, person, or other entity claiming by or through any of the foregoing, and any other entity identified in the definition of Releasor, provides for a release to the fullest extent of its authority. As a Releasor, the Governmental Entity hereby absolutely, unconditionally, and irrevocably covenants not to bring, file, or claim, or to cause, assist or permit to be brought, filed, or claimed, or to otherwise seek to establish liability for any Released Claims against any Released Entity in the RDSA in any forum whatsoever. The release provided for in the RDSA is intended by the Parties to be broad and shall be interpreted so as to give the Released Entities in the RDSA the broadest possible bar against any liability relating in any way to Released Claims and extend to the full extent of the power of the Governmental Entity to release claims. The RDSA shall be a complete bar to any Released Claim against the Released Entities.
10. The Governmental Entity hereby takes on all rights and obligations of a Participating Subdivision as set forth in the RDSA.
11. In connection with the releases provided in the RDSA, each Governmental Entity expressly waives, releases, and forever discharges any and all provisions, rights, and benefits conferred by any law of any state or territory of the United States or other jurisdiction, or principle of common law, which is similar, comparable, or equivalent to § 1542 of the California Civil Code, which reads:

General Release; extent. A general release does not extend to claims that the creditor or releasing party does not know or suspect to exist in his or her favor at the time of executing the release that, if known by him or her would have materially affected his or her settlement with the debtor or released party.

A Releasor may hereafter discover facts other than or different from those which it knows, believes, or assumes to be true with respect to the Released Claims in the RDSA, but each Governmental Entity hereby expressly waives and fully, finally, and forever settles, releases and discharges, upon the Effective Date, any and all Released Claims that may exist as of such date but which Releasors do not know or suspect to exist, whether through ignorance, oversight, error, negligence or through no fault whatsoever, and which, if known, would materially affect the Governmental Entities' decision to participate in the RDSA.

12. The Governmental Entity understands and acknowledges that nothing herein is intended to modify in any way the terms of any of the RDSA, to which Governmental Entity hereby agrees. To the extent this Combined Participation Form is interpreted differently from the RDSA in any respect, the RDSA controls.

Background Information

The City of Jenks recently concluded the 10-day Block By Block pilot program. As expected, community feedback was mixed, but one consistent theme emerged: strong interest in outdoor dining options, specifically seating located within the public right-of-way.

Jenks previously approved a temporary pilot parklet program, but no businesses activated it, and the authorization expired in December 2024. Based on current feedback and the desire for more permanent outdoor dining opportunities, staff are now presenting a non-pilot, permanent parklet option for business owners.

What the New Program Does: The attached documents outline the framework for the “Parklet Program”, which will function as a permanent regulatory option rather than a temporary test.

Key elements include:

- Public and private parklets allowed by right within the Downtown Core.
- City Council retains authority to direct the Planning Commission to review and formally adopt the parklet language into the Unified Development Ordinance (UDO) at any time.

Participating establishments must:

- Enter into an Encroachment Agreement with the City.
- Comply with all design, safety, accessibility, and operational standards outlined in the program.

Purpose and Intent:

This program provides a predictable, regulated pathway for businesses to create outdoor dining spaces that enhance the pedestrian environment and support downtown vibrancy. It also gives the City a structured mechanism to manage right-of-way use while maintaining flexibility for future refinement.

Staff Evaluation

EVALUATION | The program requires the property to be located in the Downtown Core (DC) and be zoned DC.

Staff Recommendations

RECOMMENDATIONS | Staff recommends approval of the Parklet Program.

Re: Proposed Ordinance No. 1684 revising Section 20-25-1 of the City Code pertaining to texting while driving

Proposed Ordinance No. 1684 revises Section 20-25-1 of the City Code to comply with recent changes in law found in 11 O.S. §11-901e – Use of Cell Phones in a School or Construction Zone. The following changes are being proposed:

- Makes it unlawful for any person to operate a motor vehicle while holding a hand-held cellular telephone and driving in a marked school zone or in a road construction zone.
- Replaces the definition of “Electronic communication device” with the definition to match state law.
- States that consent of the person is required before a law enforcement officer can confiscate or extract data from a cellular telephone.

See attached redline. Staff recommends approval of Ordinance No. 1685 with the approval of the emergency clause.

Sec. 20-25-1. Texting While Driving.

- (A) It shall be unlawful for any person to operate a motor vehicle on any street or highway within the City of Jenks while using a hand-held electronic communication device to manually compose, send or read an electronic text message while the vehicle is in motion.
- (B) Where any portion of a road, street, or highway is a properly marked school zone, as indicated with appropriate warning signs placed in accordance with the latest edition of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices, and a reduced speed limit is properly posted, that is in effect during certain times due to the presence or potential presence of school children, or in a road construction zone, and while a motor vehicle is in motion, it shall be unlawful for any person to operate a motor vehicle on any street or highway within the City of Jenks while holding or using a hand-held cellular telephone.
- (C) Any person who violates the provision of subsection (A) of this section shall, upon conviction, be punished by a fine of \$100.00.
- (D) The provisions of subsection (A) of this section shall not apply if the person is using the cellular telephone or electronic communication device for the sole purpose of communicating with any of the following regarding an imminent emergency situation:
- (1) An emergency response operator;
 - (2) A hospital, physician's office or health clinic;
 - (3) A provider of ambulance services;
 - (4) A provider of firefighting services; or
 - (5) A law enforcement agency.
- (E) The following words, terms and phrases, when used in this section, shall have the meanings ascribed to them in this subsection, except where the context clearly indicates a different meaning:
- Cellular telephone* means analog or digital wireless telephone authorized by the Federal Communication Commission to operate in the frequency bandwidth reserved for cellular telephones.
- Compose, send or read*, with respect to a text message, means the manual entry, sending or retrieval of a text message to communicate with any person or device.
- Electronic communication device* means an electronic device that permits the user to manually transmit a communication of written text by means other than through oral transfer or wire communication. This term does not include a device that is physically or electronically integrated into a motor vehicle or a voice-operated global positioning or navigation system that is affixed to a motor vehicle, or a hands-free device that allows the user to write, send or read a text message without the use of either hand except to activate, deactivate or initiate a feature or function, an ignition interlock device that has been installed on a motor vehicle, or amateur radio use or operation
- Text message* means and includes a text-based message, instant message, electronic message, photo, video, or electronic mail.
- (F) Without the consent of the person, a law enforcement officer shall not:
1. Confiscate a cellular telephone or electronic communication device for the purpose of determining compliance with this section.
 2. Confiscate a cellular telephone or electronic communication device and retain it as evidence pending trial for a violation of this section; or

3. Extract or otherwise download information from a cellular telephone or electronic communication device for a violation of this section unless:
 - a. The law enforcement officer has probable cause to believe that the cellular telephone or electronic communication device has been used in the commission of a crime,
 - b. The information is extracted or otherwise downloaded under a valid search warrant, or
 - c. Otherwise authorized by law.

ORDINANCE NO. 1684

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 20 OF THE CITY OF JENKS CODE OF ORDINANCES “TRAFFIC” SECTION 20-25-1 “TEXTING WHILE DRIVING” TO INCLUDE A PROHIBITION FOR USE OF A HAND-HELD DEVICE IN A SCHOOL OR CONSTRUCTION ZONE, TO UPDATE THE DEFINITION OF ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATION DEVICE, AND TO ADD LIMITATIONS UPON LAW ENFORCEMENT FROM STATE LAW AND TO RE-LETTER EXISTING SUBSECTIONS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JENKS, OKLAHOMA:

SECTION I. *Section 20-25-1 is be amended to add a new subsection (B) which reads as follows:*

Where any portion of a road, street, or highway is a properly marked school zone, as indicated with appropriate warning signs placed in accordance with the latest edition of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices, and a reduced speed limit is properly posted, that is in effect during certain times due to the presence or potential presence of school children, or in a road construction zone, and while a motor vehicle is in motion, it shall be unlawful for any person to operate a motor vehicle on any street or highway within the City of Jenks while holding or using a hand-held cellular telephone.

SECTION II. *Section 20-25-1 is amended to re-letter existing subsections (B)-(D) to become subsections (C)-(E).*

SECTION III. *Section 20-25-1, existing subsection (D) (re-lettered to be new subsection (E)) is be amended to replace the definition of “Electronic communication device” with the following new definition to match state law:*

Electronic communication device means an electronic device that permits the user to manually transmit a communication of written text by means other than through oral transfer or wire communication. This term does not include a device that is physically or electronically integrated into a motor vehicle or a voice-operated global positioning or navigation system that is affixed to a motor vehicle, or a hands-free device that allows the user to write, send or read a text message without the use of either hand except to activate, deactivate or initiate a feature or function, an ignition interlock device that has been installed on a motor vehicle, or amateur radio use or operation.

SECTION III. *Section 20-25-1 is be amended to add a new subsection (F) which reads as follows:*

Without the consent of the person, a law enforcement officer shall not:

1. Confiscate a cellular telephone or electronic communication device for the purpose of determining compliance with this section.
2. Confiscate a cellular telephone or electronic communication device and retain it as evidence pending trial for a violation of this section; or
3. Extract or otherwise download information from a cellular telephone or electronic communication device for a violation of this section unless:
 - a. The law enforcement officer has probable cause to believe that the cellular telephone or electronic communication device has been used in the commission of a crime,
 - b. The information is extracted or otherwise downloaded under a valid search warrant, or
 - c. Otherwise authorized by law.

SECTION IV. *If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance or any part thereof is for any reason found to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this ordinance or any part thereof.*

SECTION V. *That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby expressly repealed.*

SECTION VI. *Since the immediate operation of the provisions of the ordinance is necessary for the preservation of public health, welfare and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the City Council.*

Proposed Ordinance No. 1685 revisions to Sections 5-1-1 and 5-1-8 of the City Code to include the definition of a leafleteer, adding leaflets and leafleteers to the no knock list provisions and including the same prohibitions for a leafleteer as a solicitor.

- Section 5-1-1 (A) (5) amended to include leafleteers.
- Section 5-1-8 (A) amended to include a new number 5 defining a leafleteer.
- Section 5-1-8 (C) amended to include leaflets and leafleteers to the No Knock list.
- Section 5-1-8 (D) amended to include a new subsection (3) which requires flyers to be securely placed so as not to create litter.
- Section 5-1-8 (E) (1) amended to include a leafleteer to solicitor prohibitions when the occupant is on the no knock list.

Sec. 5-1-1. License Tax Levied on Certain Persons, Etc.

- (A) A license tax is hereby levied on every person, firm, association or corporation engaging in, exercising, or pursuing any of the following businesses, professions, trades, occupations or privileges in this city, in the amounts set forth in the Master Fee Schedule for the following:
- (1) For each itinerant show, exhibition, or entertainment (comedy, musical, dramatic, or other) which charges admission provided that this shall not apply to circuses, menageries, street fairs and carnivals, nor to shows, etc., given for the benefit of charity, education or other nonprofit purposes.
 - (2) For each circus traveling by railroad.
 - (3) For each circus traveling by land for the right to parade alone in each case above.
 - (4) For each street fair or carnival (including all activities under its auspices).
 - (5) For each person, agent or solicitor selling, or taking orders for goods, wares, magazines, or other things of any kind. No such sales are to be made before 9:00 a.m. or after 9:00 p.m. on any day. All solicitors, however, shall register with the City. All solicitors, ~~and~~ canvassers ~~and~~ leafleteers must comply with section 5-1-8.
 - (6) For each person peddling, or selling from a stand, cart, other vehicle, basket, or similar thing, drinks, ice cream or other frozen foods of any kind, sandwiches or any other kind of foods. Local non-profit, charitable, civic, religious or educational organizations are exempted from the payment of the license tax. In lieu of payment of the fee, an applicant may pay an annual license fee. Such vendor shall provide proof of sales tax payment. All such persons, whether exempted from the tax or not, shall register with the Jenks Police Department.
 - (7) For each person running a Ferris wheel, merry-go-round, small cars or similar apparatus, when not under the auspices of a street fair, carnival, or circus.
 - (8) For each itinerant photographer or itinerant person selling or taking orders for photographs.
 - (9) For each snooker, pool, or billiard hall.
 - (10) For each domino, card, and/or other game parlor, or in case game is not played on a table, per playing space or area.
 - (11) For each coin-operated music device or coin-operated amusement device, as defined by 68 O.S. § 1501, payable to the City of Jenks, in addition to any license fee payable to the Oklahoma Tax Commission.
 - (12) For each coin-operated vending device, as defined by 68 O.S. 1501, requiring a coin or thing of value and for each coin-operated vending device requiring a coin or thing of value as well as an annual license fee. Such fees are payable to the City of Jenks and are in addition to any license fee payable to the Oklahoma Tax Commission.
 - (13) For each pawnbroker.
 - (14) For each food truck operator: To obtain license, food truck operator must provide the City with the following: copy of current certificate of liability insurance; copy of mobile food establishment license issued by the Oklahoma State Department of Health, and copy of sales tax permit issued by the Oklahoma Tax Commission. Upon payment of the license tax and receipt of a license, food trucks may operate in the right-of-way with the permission of the adjacent property owner and subject to all pertinent local laws including the traffic and nuisance codes. Food trucks must move every 12 hours. Food trucks may not remain at one physical address for more than 12 hours unless in conjunction with a City-approved single event or celebration [See also OAC 310:257-17-3]. Food trucks may not operate at one physical address for more than three consecutive days or five total days in any 30-day period without first obtaining City Council approval. Food truck licenses are invalid during special events

within the area approved for the special event or within 200 yards of the event. The City may provide written permission for the outdoor vendor to continue to conduct business during the special event but may request the vendor to relocate or adjust operations.

Sec. 5-1-8. Solicitors, Canvassers, and Flyer Distribution.

A. *Definitions.* As used in this article, the following words have the meanings indicated:

1. *Canvasser* means a person who attempts to make personal contact with a resident at his or her residence without prior specific invitation or appointment from the resident, for the non-commercial primary purpose of:
 - a. Attempting to enlist support for or against a particular religion, philosophy, ideology, political party, issue, or candidate, even if incidental to such purpose the canvasser accepts the donation of money for or against such cause;
 - b. Attempting to obtain a donation to a particular patriotic, philanthropic, social service, welfare, benevolent, educational, civic, fraternal, charitable, political or religious purpose.
2. *Commercial flyer* means any printed or written material, any sample or device, circular, leaflet, pamphlet, newspaper, magazine, publication, booklet, handbill or other printed or otherwise reproduced original or copy of any manner of literature or paper containing a written or pictorial message that is predominately and essentially an advertisement and is distributed or circulated for advertising purposes or any direct or indirect private financial gain of any person or entity so engaged as advertiser or distributor, except that a telephone directory or newspaper of general circulation in the city published priority for the purpose of disseminating news shall not be considered a "commercial flyer."
3. *Non-commercial flyer* means any printed or written material, any sample or device, circular, leaflet, pamphlet, newspaper, magazine, booklet, handbill or any other printed or otherwise reproduced original or copy of any manner of literature or paper containing a written or pictorial message that is distributed or circulated solely for nonprofit purposes.
4. *Solicitor* means a person who attempts to make personal contact with a resident at his or her residence without prior specific invitation or appointment from the resident, for the primary purpose of attempting to sell a good or service, whether or not the goods or services are actually delivered at the time of sales.
5. *Leafleteer* means a person who distributes leaflets or handbills, whether by handing them directly to individuals or by placing them on or at residential or commercial properties.

B. *Registration required.*

No person shall act as a solicitor within the City without first registering with the City in accordance with this chapter. Canvassers are not required to register but may do so for the purpose of reassuring City residents of the canvasser's good faith.

C. *"No-knock" list.*

The City Clerk shall make available on the City web site a list of persons within the City who restrict visits to their residential property (including their leasehold, in the case of a tenant) and who prohibit the placement or delivery of handbills or leaflets on their property by solicitors or leafleteers. Each solicitor or leafleteer registered pursuant to this article shall be responsible for the verification of addresses contained on the No Knock list prior to engaging in solicitation within the City; such verification may be made by reviewing the "no knock" list maintained on the City's web site.

D. *Distribution of flyers.* Any person attempting to distribute commercial or non-commercial flyers within the City shall observe the following regulations:

1. No flyer shall be left at, or attached to, any mailbox or any sign, utility pole, transit shelter or other structure within the public right-of-way.
 2. No flyer shall be left at, or attached to, any privately-owned property in a manner that causes damage to such privately-owned property.
 3. No flyer shall be left unless it is properly placed or secured so that it does not blow away and create litter.
 4. Distribution of flyers shall occur only between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 9:00 p.m.
- E. *General prohibitions.*
1. No solicitor or leafleteer shall:
 - a. Enter upon private property where the current occupant is included the property on the city's "no-knock" list, regardless of whether a City-issued sticker indicating the property has been included on the city's "no-knock" list is posted, or remain upon any private property where any form of sign or sticker is clearly displayed advising the occupant does not wish to be called upon by solicitors, including but not limited to the city-issued "no-knock" sticker or a "no soliciting" sign.
 - b. Use, or attempt to use, any entrance other than the front or main entrance to the dwelling, or step from the sidewalk or indicated walkway (where one exists) leading from the right-of-way to the front or main entrance, except by express invitation of the resident or occupant of the property.
 - c. Remove any yard sign, door or entrance sign, or sticker that gives notice to such person that the resident or occupant does not invite visitors.
 2. It shall be unlawful for any person, organization, corporation, or business entity to instruct, direct, command, order, organize or otherwise arrange for any person to engage in solicitation in violation of subsections A—E of this section or in violation of section 5-1-1 of this chapter.
 3. It shall be an affirmative defense to any violation of this chapter that the solicitor has an express invitation from the resident or occupant of a dwelling allowing him or her to enter upon any posted property.

ORDINANCE NO. 1685

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 5 OF THE CITY OF JENKS CODE OF ORDINANCES "BUSINESS AND OCCUPATIONS" SECTION 5-1-1 "LICENSE TAX LEVIED ON CERTAIN PERSONS, ETC." TO ADD LEAFLETEER TO THE LIST OF SOLICITORS AND CANVASSERS WHO MUST COMPLY WITH SECTION 5-1-1 (A) (5); AMENDING SECTION 5-1-8 "SOLICITORS, CANVASSERS, AND FLYER DISTRIBUTION" BY AMENDING SECTION 5-1-8 (A) (5) TO ADD THE DEFINITION OF A LEAFLETEER; AMENDING SECTION 5-1-8 (C) TO INCLUDE ADDITIONAL LANGUAGE THAT PROHIBITS PLACEMENT OR DELIVERY OF HANDBILLS OR LEAFLETS BY SOLICITORS OR LEAFLETEERS; AMENDING SECTION 5-1-8 (D) TO ADD A NEW NUMBER 3 TO REQUIRE SECURE PLACEMENT OF FLYERS SO AS NOT TO CREATE LITTER; AMENDING SECTION 5-1-8 (E) (1) BY ADDING LEAFLETEERS TO THE LIST OF GENERAL PROHIBITIONS FOR SOLICITORS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JENKS, OKLAHOMA:

***SECTION I.** Section 5-1-1 (A) (5) is to be amended as follows:*

For each person, agent or solicitor selling, or taking orders for goods, wares, magazines, or other things of any kind. No such sales are to be made before 9:00 a.m. or after 9:00 p.m. on any day. All solicitors, however, shall register with the City. All solicitors, canvassers and leafleteers must comply with section 5-1-8.

***SECTION II.** Section 5-1-8 (A) is to be amended to add a new subsection (5) which reads as follows:*

5. *Leafleteer* means a person who distributes leaflets or handbills, whether by handing them directly to individuals or by placing them on or at residential or commercial properties.

***SECTION III.** Section 5-1-8 (C) is to be amended to include additional language which reads as follows:*

C. "No-knock" list.

The City Clerk shall make available on the City web site a list of persons within the City who restrict visits to their residential property (including their leasehold, in the case of a tenant) and who prohibit the placement or delivery of handbills or leaflets on their property by solicitors or leafleteers. Each solicitor or leafleteer registered pursuant to this article shall be responsible for the verification of addresses contained on the No

Knock list prior to engaging in solicitation within the City; such verification may be made by reviewing the "no knock" list maintained on the City's web site.

SECTION III. *Section 5-1-8 (D) is to be amended to add a new subsection (3) which reads as follows:*

3. No flyer shall be left unless it is properly placed or secured so that it does not blow away and create litter.

SECTION IV. *Section 5-1-8 (D) is to be amended to renumber the previous subsection (3) to subsection (4).*

SECTION V. *Section 5-1-8 (E)(1) is to be amended to "leafleteer" to general prohibitions reads as follows:*

1. No solicitor or leafleteer shall:
 - a. Enter upon private property where the current occupant is included the property on the city's "no-knock" list, regardless of whether a City-issued sticker indicating the property has been included on the city's "no-knock" list is posted, or remain upon any private property where any form of sign or sticker is clearly displayed advising the occupant does not wish to be called upon by solicitors, including but not limited to the city-issued "no-knock" sticker or a "no soliciting" sign.
 - b. Use, or attempt to use, any entrance other than the front or main entrance to the dwelling, or step from the sidewalk or indicated walkway (where one exists) leading from the right-of-way to the front or main entrance, except by express invitation of the resident or occupant of the property.
 - c. Remove any yard sign, door or entrance sign, or sticker that gives notice to such person that the resident or occupant does not invite visitors.

SECTION VIII. SEVERABILITY. *If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance or any part thereof is for any reason found to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this ordinance or any part thereof.*

SECTION IX. REPEALER. *That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby expressly repealed.*

SECTION X. EMERGENCY. *Since the immediate operation of the provisions of the ordinance is necessary for the preservation of public health, welfare and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the City Council.*

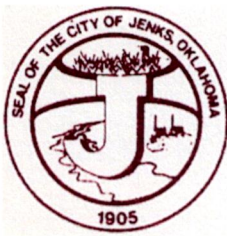

Plans and specifications were completed for Phase 2 Widening of Elm Street (121st to 131st Street) by Marquardt Engineering, LLC. The project was advertised for bids, and bids from four (4) bidders were opened on March 20, 2026. A tabulation of the bids is attached and summarized below:

The tabulation shows a base bid for all roadway construction components in the amount of \$6,625,048.80. The apparent low bidder is Paragon Contractors, LLC (Tulsa, OK). The Engineer's estimate of probable cost of construction was \$7,305,483.87. The bid by Paragon Contractors, LLC was 9.31% below the Engineer's estimate. A total of 450 calendar days to complete the work was bid. A recommendation to award this bid by our design engineer is attached.

A total of \$16,000,000.00 was approved by the voters in the 2020 G.O. Bond election. On November 4, 2024, two (2) contracts were awarded for Phase 1 (111th Street to 121st Street) which were funded from the bond:

- Construction
Paragon Contractors, LLC. \$9,177,017.68
- Construction Management and Laboratory Services
Standard Engineering + Testing Services \$566,826.00

During construction, change orders have been issued and the total project costs allocated to the project currently is \$11,850,686.16. As a result, the present balance in available bond funds is \$4,149,313.84 (Account No. 27-840-5393). An additional \$2,475,734.96 is needed in order to award the bid of \$6,625,048.80 for Phase 2 construction. These funds are being requested to be appropriated from the FY25-26 One-Cent Capital Fund fund balance. A similar action will be requested to fund Phase 2 construction management and laboratory services.

Staff requests to award a contract for construction of Phase 2 Widening of Elm Street (121st to 131st Streets) in the total amount of \$6,625,048.80 to Paragon Contractors, LLC (Tulsa, OK); funding in the amount of \$4,149,313.84 to be paid from 2020 G.O. Bond funds (Account No. 27-840-5393) and

Elm Street Widening (121st – 131st Street) Phase 2 – Bid Award

\$2,475,734.96 to be appropriated from the One-Cent Capital Fund fund- balance to be budgeted to Account No. 27-840-5393.

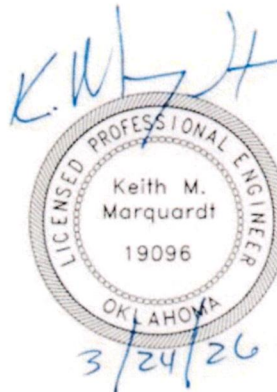
