Ordinance 1657, related to JZ 24 PUD 151, rezoning a piece of property to RS-2 (Residential Single Family) and establishing the Planned Unit Development 151 Overlay District (PUD 151), repealing all ordinances or parts thereof in conflict herewith, providing for severability, and declaring an emergency. General Location: 131st and Kimberly Clark Pl.
4. Emergency Clause for Ordinance 1657, making it effective immediately upon passage since the immediate operations of the provisions of the Ordinance is necessary for the preservation of public health and safety
5. PA 24-39, a Major Amendment to the Comprehensive Plan Land Use Map from Multi-Family to Regional Commercial. General Location: north of 91st St, west of the

Arkansas River

6. Ordinance 1658, updating §§ 16-3 (Base District Specific Standards) of the Jenks Zoning Code (Unified Development Ordinance) amending the Bulk and Dimensional Standards for new developments, increasing the minimum lot requirements for certain residential zonings, repealing all ordinances or parts thereof in conflict herewith, providing for severability, and declaring an emergency.
